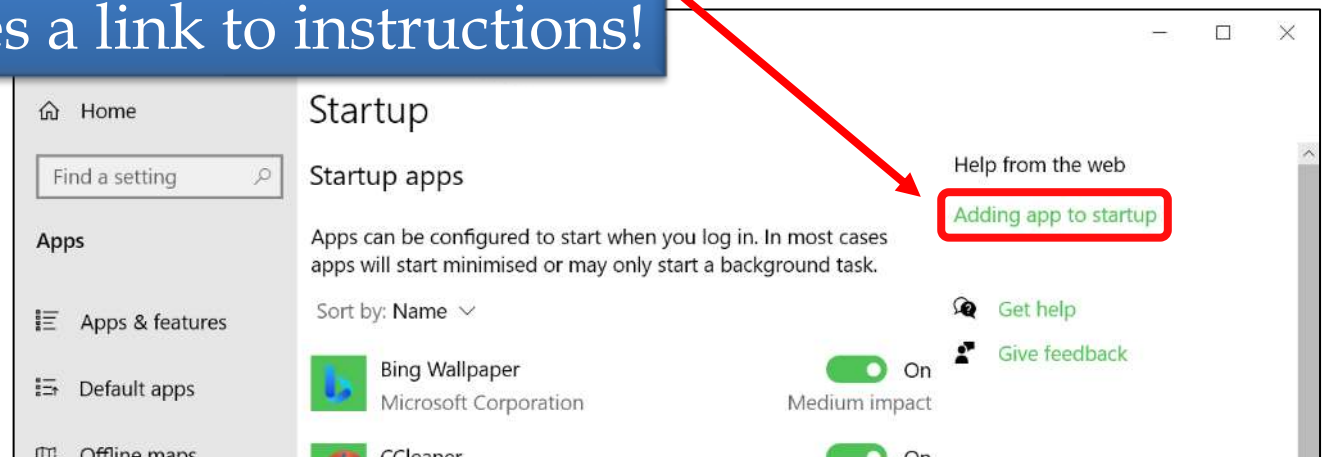


Auto-starting an app

- Alan showed how to *stop* an app from auto-starting with Windows
- What if you *want* an app to auto-start with Windows and it currently is not
- App won't be on list in *Settings* | *Apps* | *Startup*

No worry

- Windows includes a link to instructions!





Instructions incomplete!

Add an app to run automatically at startup in Windows 10

- 1 Select the **Start** button and scroll to find the app you want to run at startup.
- 2 Right-click the app, select **More**, and then select **Open file location**. This opens the location where the shortcut to the app is saved. If there isn't an option for **Open file location**, it means the app can't run at startup.
- 3 With the file location open, press the **Windows logo key + R**, type **shell:startup**, then select **OK**. This opens the **Startup** folder.
- 4 Copy and paste the shortcut to the app from the file location to the **Startup** folder.

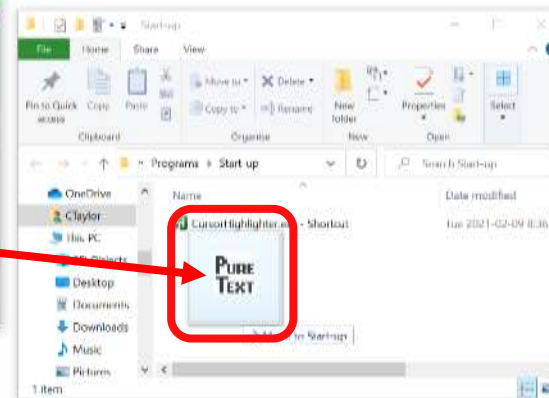
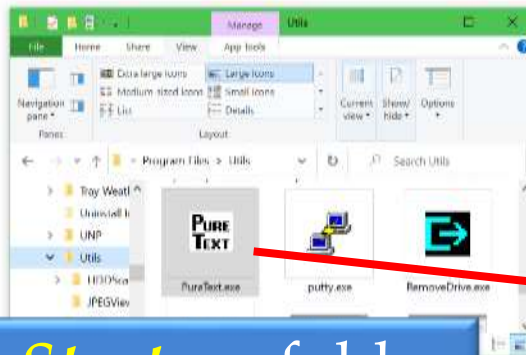
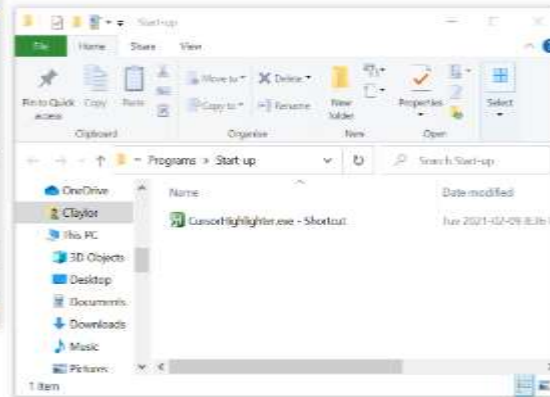
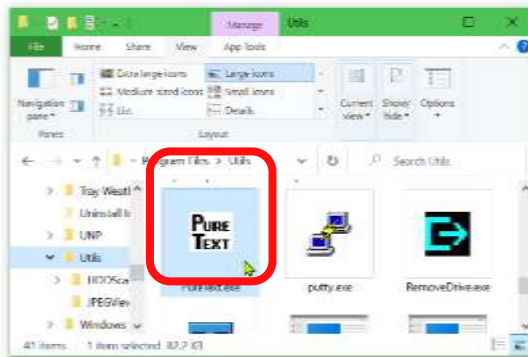
Apps not on Start menu

- Open another File Explorer window
 - hold shift key and click the File Explorer icon on taskbar
- Find executable (or shortcut to it) you want to auto-start



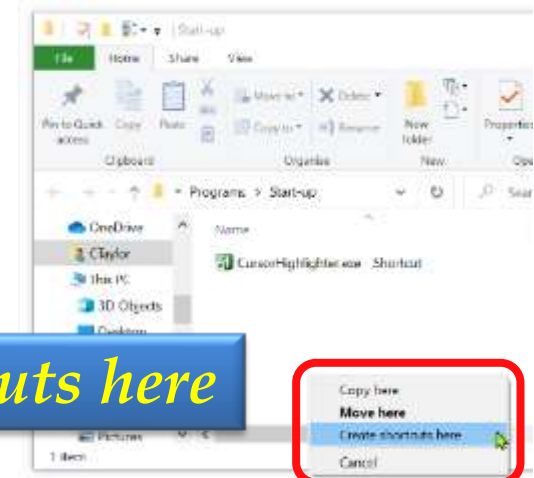
Apps not on Start menu

Right-click icon & hold down the right mouse button



Drag to *Start-up* folder
& release mouse button

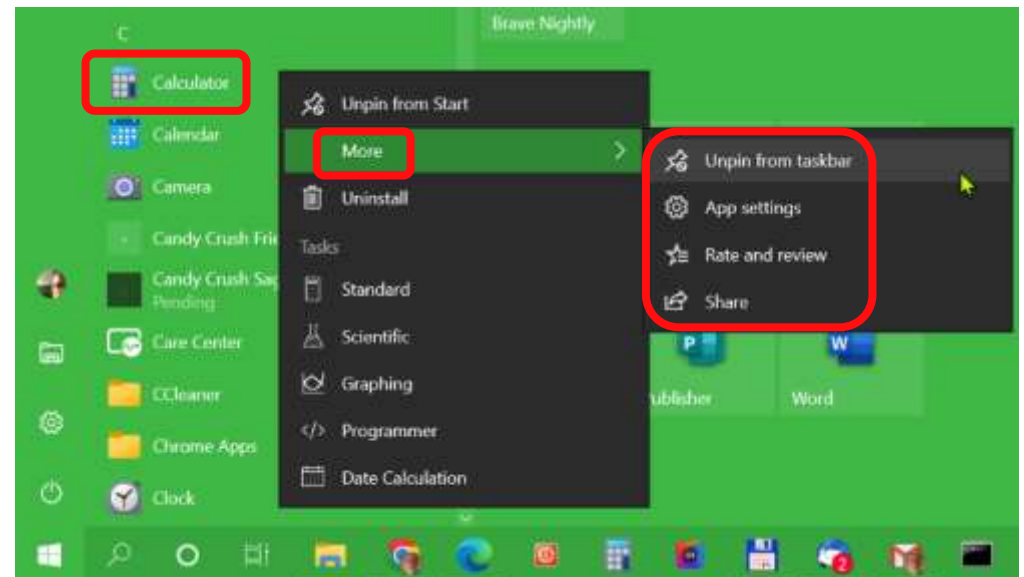
Choose *Create shortcuts here*

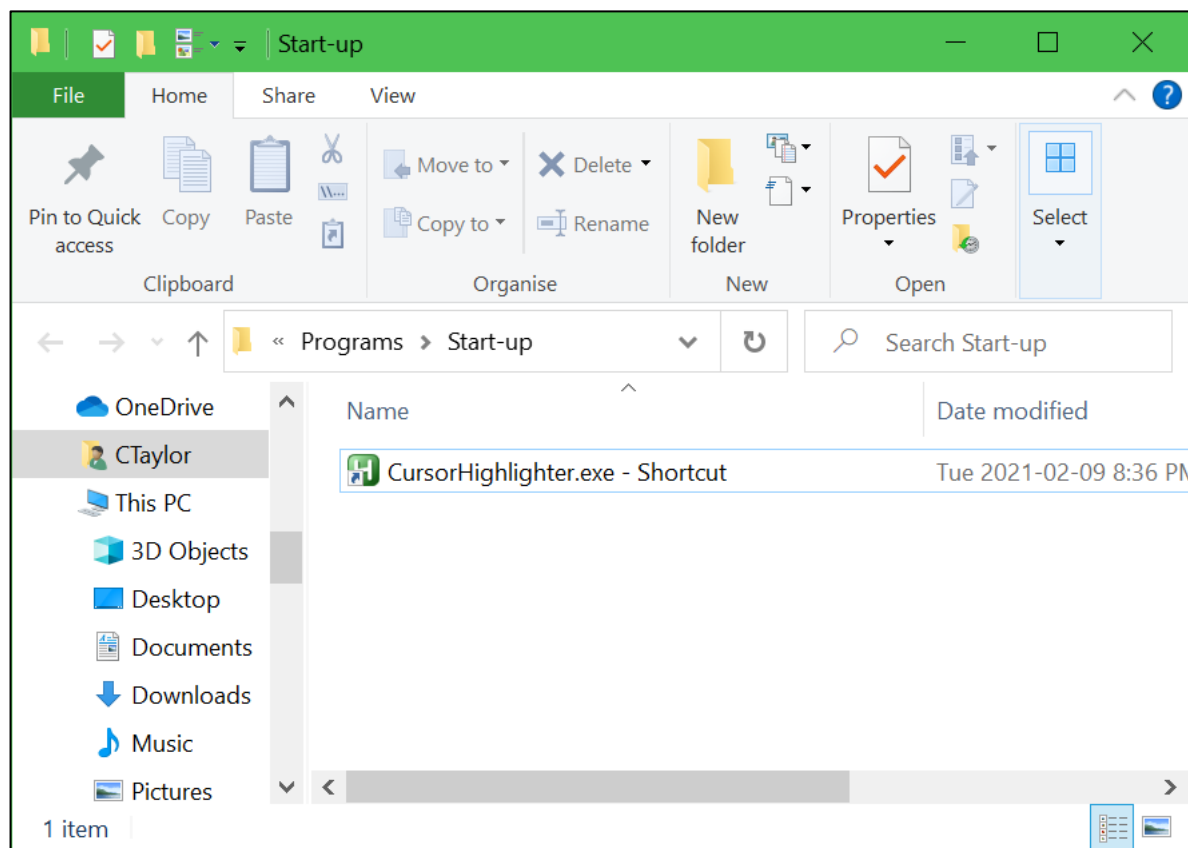
- Right-click icon in Start menu, choose *More*
- No *Open file location*?
 - It's a *Store* app!

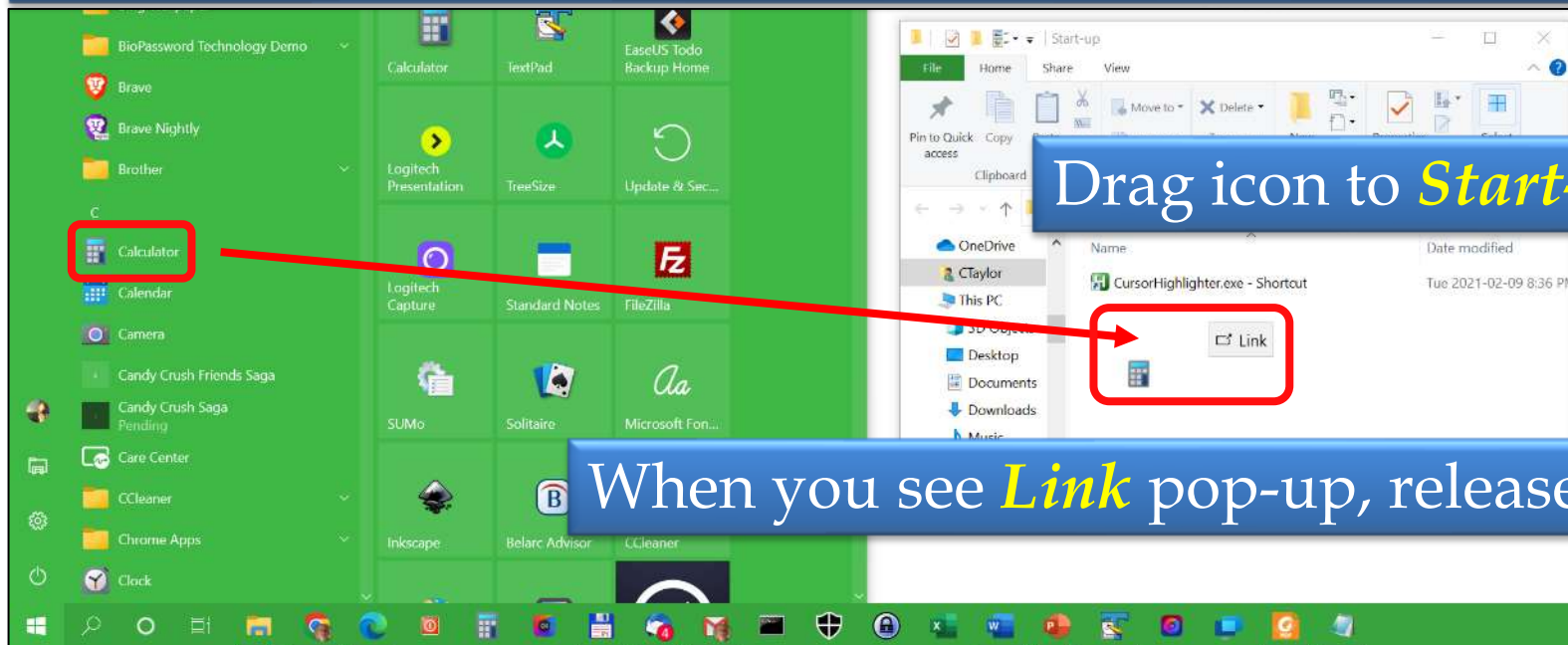
- Open the *Start-up* folder
 - press Windows logo key + R
 - type *shell:startup*, then select *OK* to open the *Startup* folder.





Store apps

Left-click icon in *Start* & hold down the mouse button



Drag icon to *Start-up* folder

When you see *Link* pop-up, release mouse button

4-in *Task Scheduler* click *Create Task*

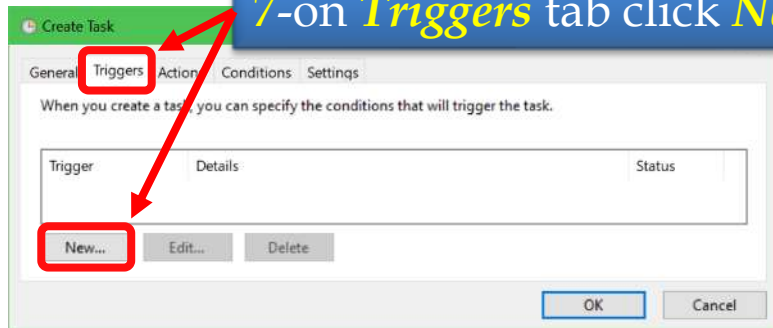
5-give task a name

6-check *Run with highest privileges*

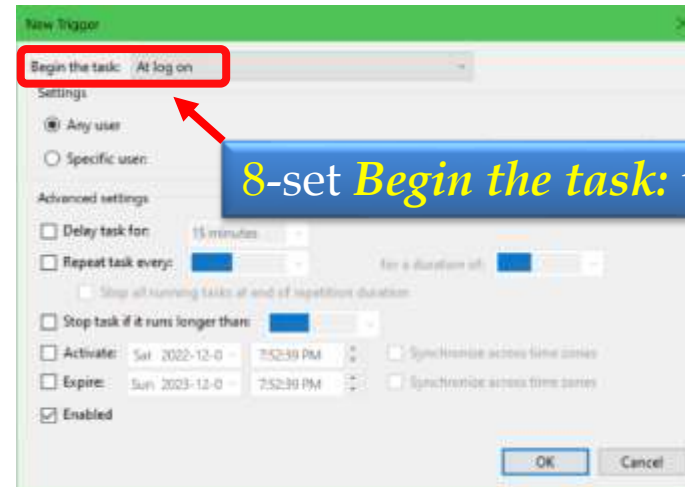

How to add new time servers on Windows 10

If you prefer to use a different time server that isn't in the list, it's also possible to include any NTP server you want.

1. Open **Control Panel**.
2. Click on **Clock, Language, and Region**.
3. Click on **Date and Time**.
4. Click on the **Internet Time** tab.
5. Click the **Change settings** button.
6. Check that the **Synchronize with an internet time server** option is selected.
7. Click the drop-down menu, and next to "Server," and type the new address of the time server.
8. Click the **Update now** button to resynchronize.
9. Click **OK**.
10. Click **Apply**.
11. Click **OK**.

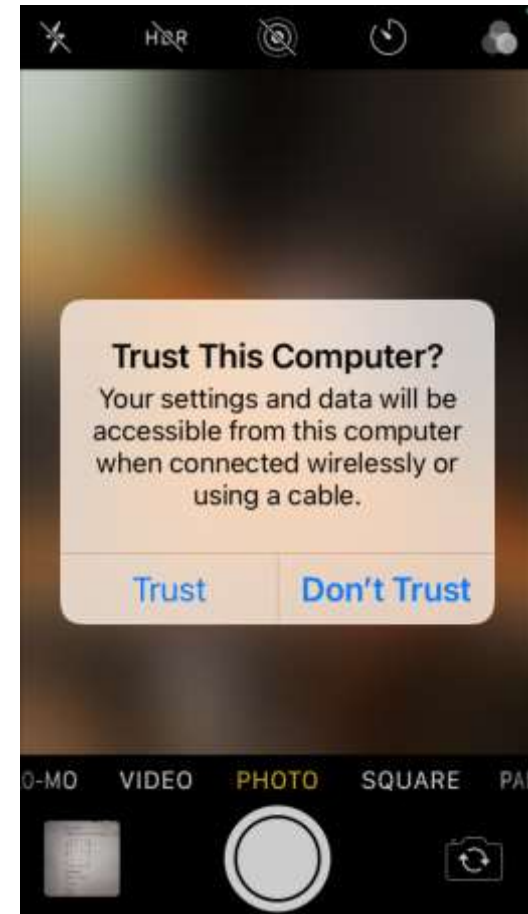
Copy like lightning!

- Connect iPhone to PC using lightning-to-USB (charging) cable
- Load File Explorer
- Copy files from iPhone to PC folder



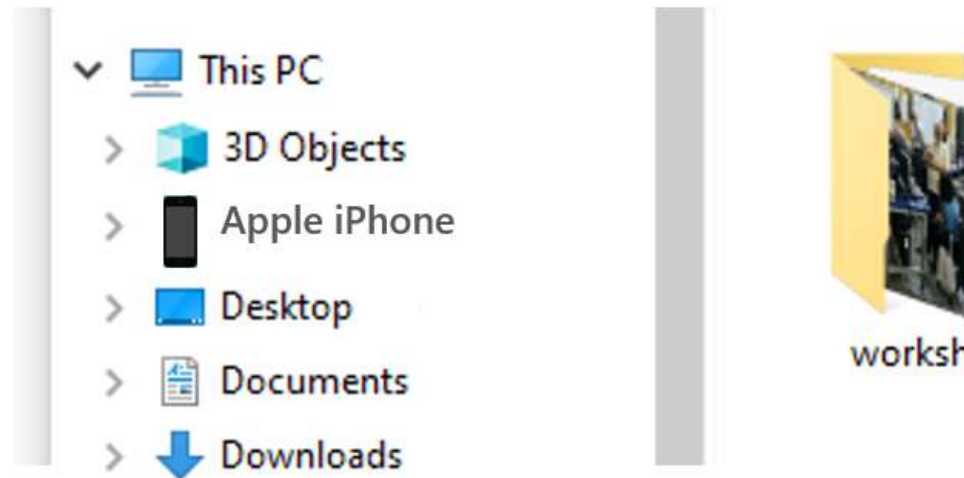
On the iPhone:

- Plug cable that came with the iPhone to the USB port on your PC
- Tell the iPhone to trust the computer
- Enter your Device Passcode on the iPhone if asked



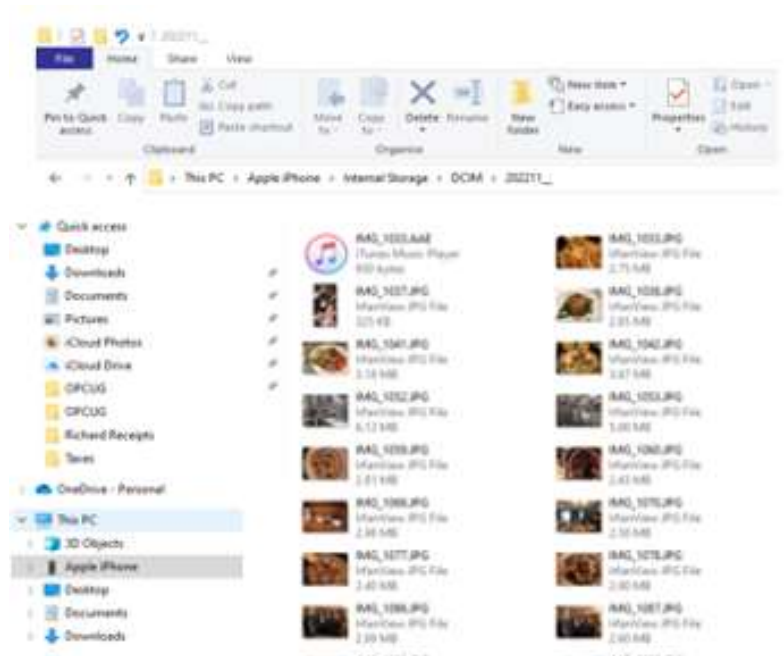
On the PC:

- Open File Explorer
- Create a file folder (or folders) for the photos to be copied to
- The iPhone looks like a folder (with sub-folders) to the PC

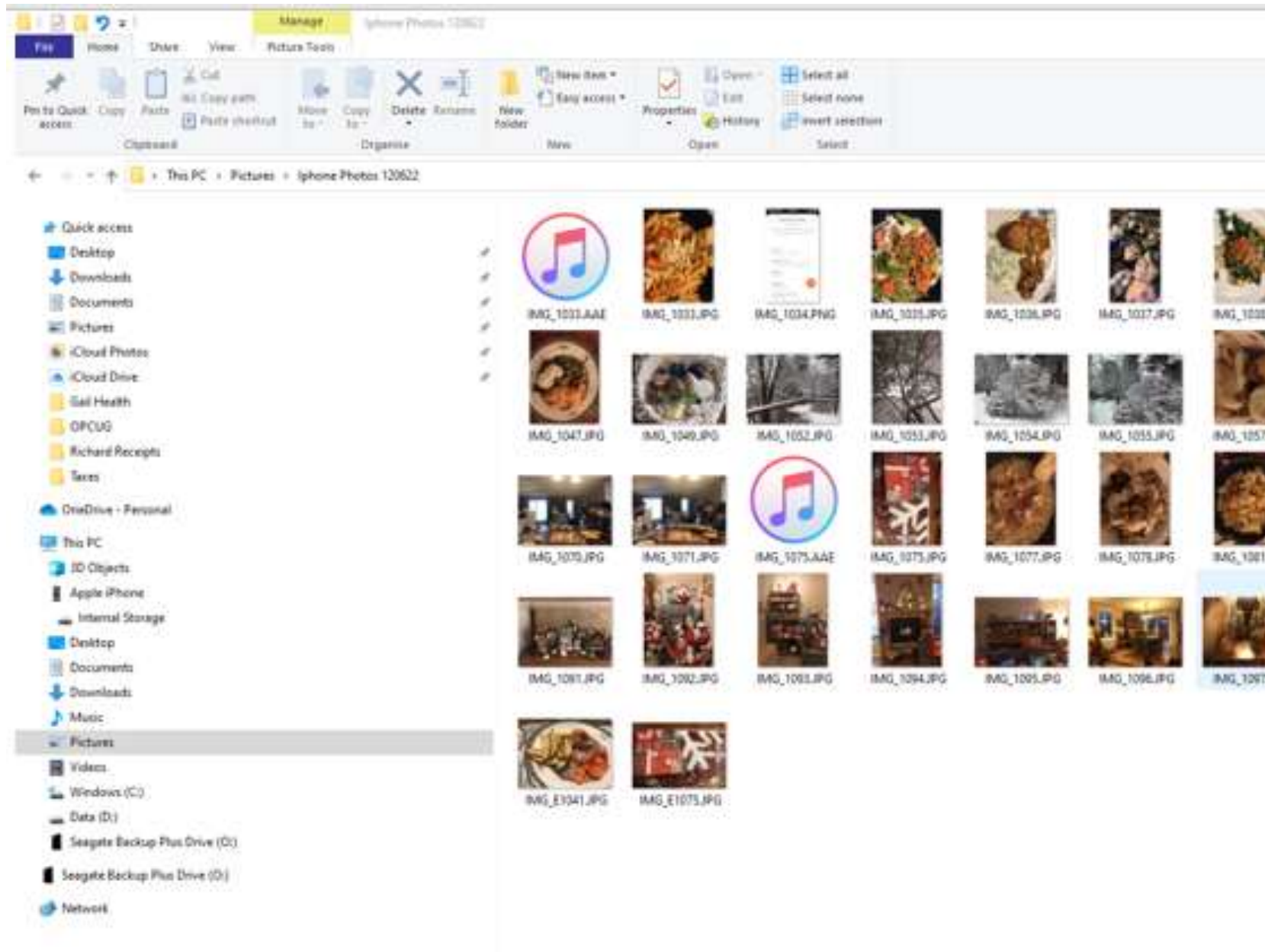


Copying iPhone photos:

- Click on *Internal Storage* > *DCIM*
- A list of folders with images will display
(NOTE: These do not look like the folders on your iPhone)
- Choose a folder
- Select images to copy
- Click on Copy
- Go to the destination folder
- Paste

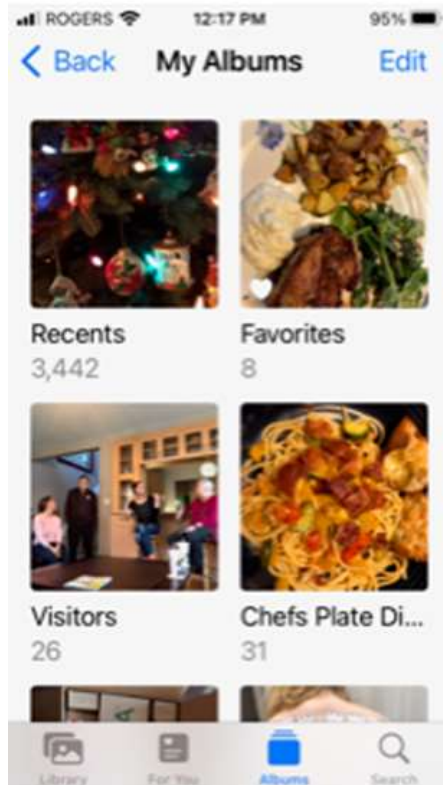


Paste images to File Explorer

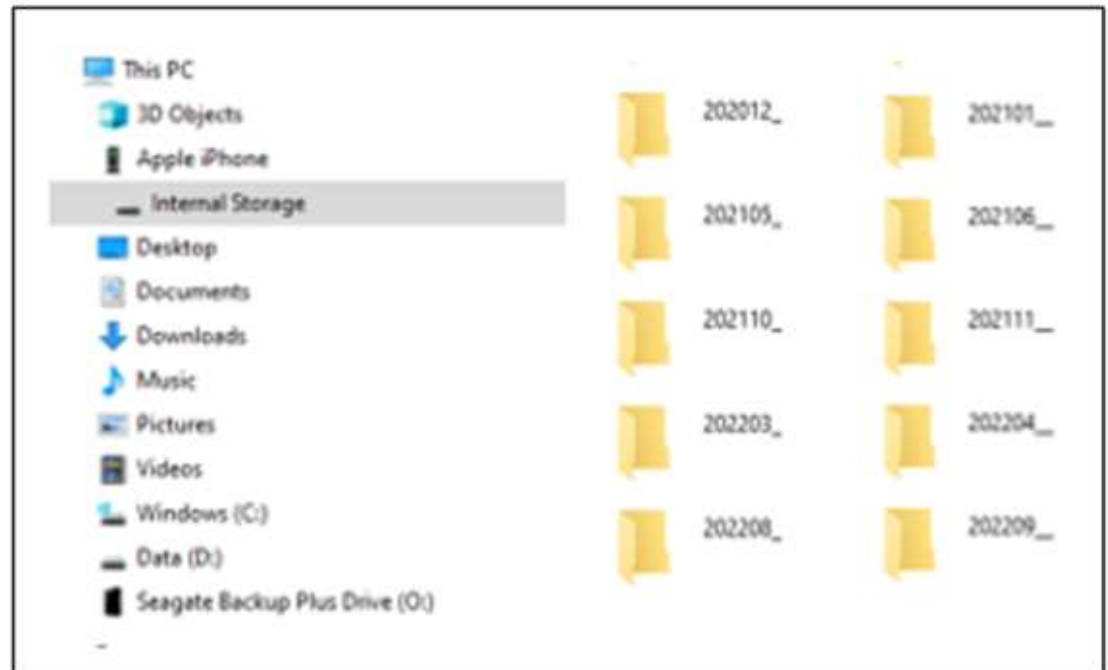


Quirks and Glitches

- Apple does not show the same file structure on the iPhone.
- On the iPhone you can put photos in folders, but those folders are not the ones showing on the PC.

Quirks and Glitches



- Apple does not copy photos it has downloaded before which can be frustrating - and it does not tell you which ones!
- There are some file formats that don't download
- If the images are stored in iCloud and not on your device, you have to use the iCloud desktop app

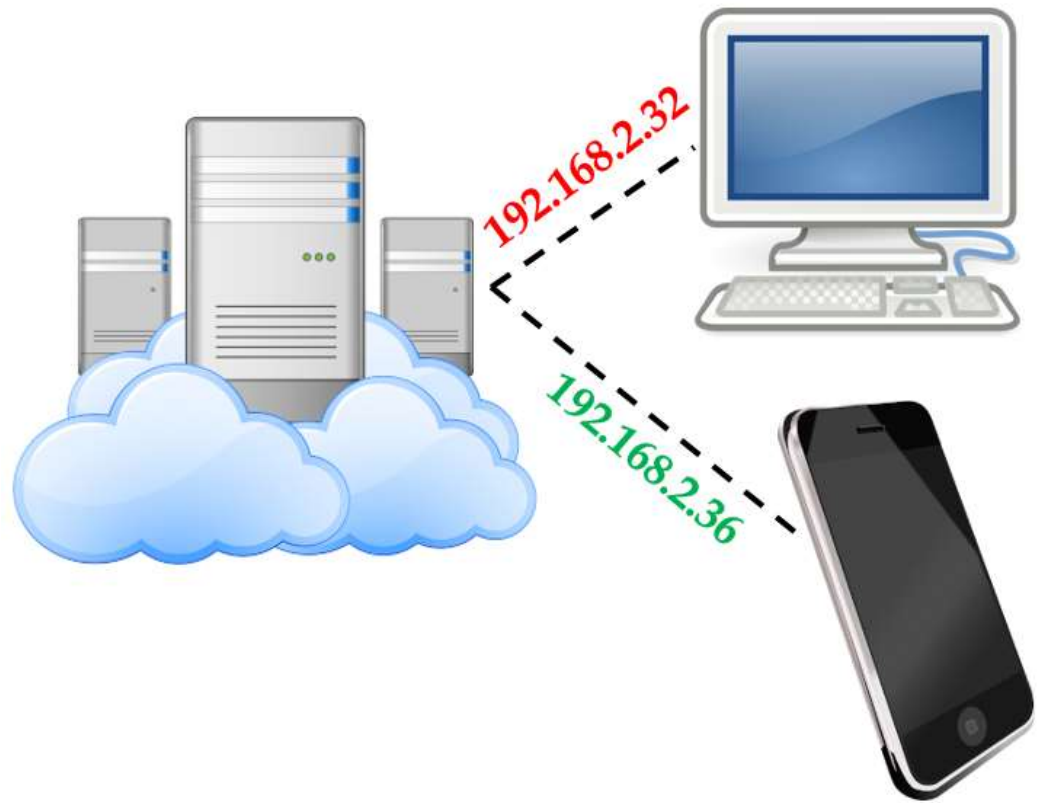

Now we are on-line it's up to YOU to continue the tradition!

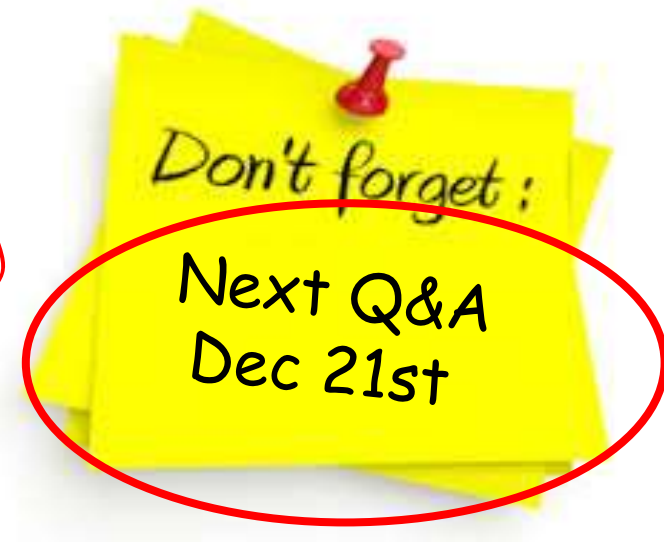
Most needed items include:
