✳ Answer

Based on the search results, here are the key points about editing HTML on Google Sites:

1. You cannot directly edit the full HTML of a Google Sites page. Google Sites does not provide access to edit the underlying HTML code of entire pages ⁷.
2. However, you can embed custom HTML, CSS, and JavaScript code into Google Sites pages using the HTML Box or Embed feature:

To view the HTML code underlying a page on a Google Sites website using Vivaldi, you have a few options:

1. Use the keyboard shortcut:

Press Ctrl + U (on Windows/Linux) or Cmd + Opt + U (on macOS) while on the Google Sites page. This will open the page source in a new tab, displaying the underlying HTML code ¹.

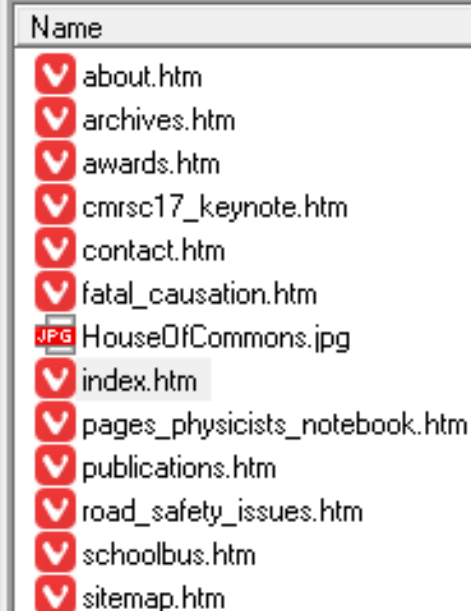
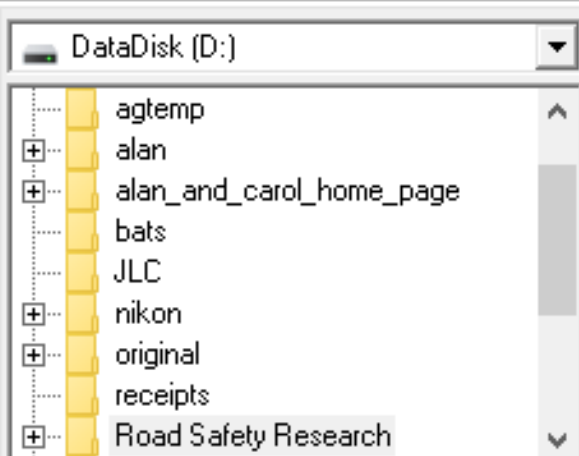
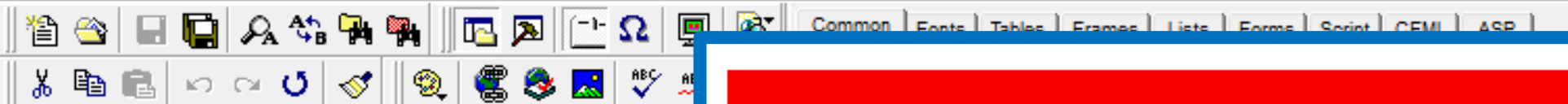
2. Use the context menu:

Right-click anywhere on the Google Sites page and select "View page source" from the context menu. This will also open the page source in a separate tab ¹.

3. Use the Developer Tools:

Press F12 or right-click and select "Inspect" to open Vivaldi's Developer Tools. Navigate to the "Elements" tab to view and interact with the HTML structure of the page ¹.

It's important to note that Google Sites uses a lot of JavaScript to generate its content dynamically. As a result, the initial HTML source you see might not contain all the elements visible on the rendered page. The Developer Tools method (option 3) is often more useful for inspecting the final rendered HTML structure.

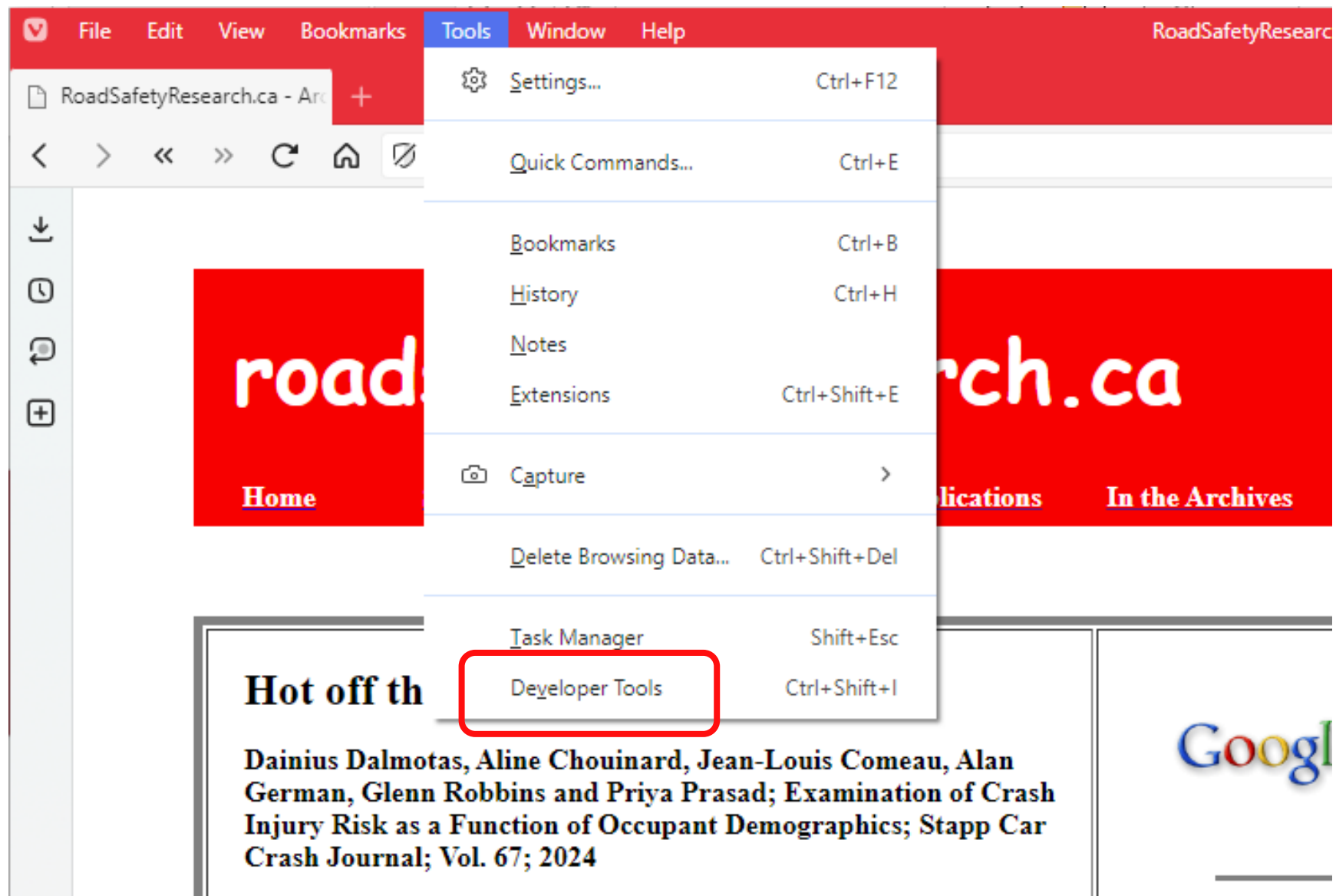

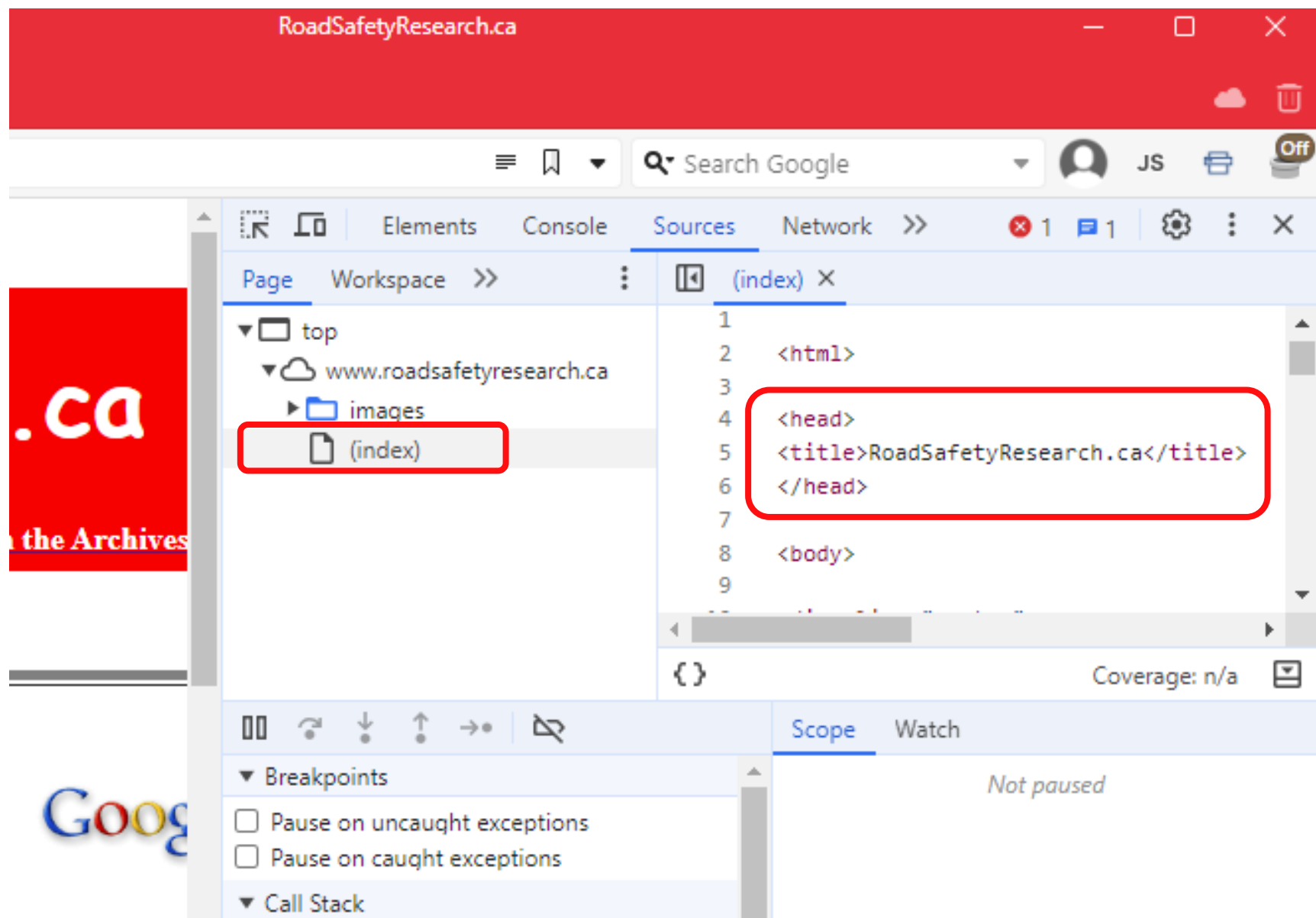

7 Ways to Improve Your Phone's Battery Life (Android & iPhone)

YouTubeTech

- Lower screen brightness & use low power/battery saving mode
- If phone has OLED screen – use dark mode
 - non-OLED screens have an “always on” backlight
- Use WiFi rather than cellular data: WiFi uses less power
- If in an area where you are not going to be using WiFi, turn it off
- Find which apps are using the most power
 - restrict background use or uninstall unneeded apps
- See how often phone is checking for new mail
 - *Push* notifications are constantly checking for new mail
- Replace the battery
- Avoid fast charging
- Use *Optimized battery charging* (iOS) / *Adaptive charging* (Android)
- Keep charge between 40% and 80%
 - ideal, but don't sweat it too much

Ad-blocking DNS

YouTubeTech

- DNS: phone book for Internet
 - translates domain names such as *double-click.net* into IP addresses your computer needs to connect & load content
- Change DNS server setting
 - use DNS server that knows about servers used to deliver ads
- Ads removed from your web browsing
 - faster browsing
 - less content to load
 - less annoying browsing
 - don't have to see ads
 - potential more secure browsing
 - some malware delivered by ads
 - no browser extension or additional software to load

- NextDNS (<https://nextdns.io/>)
 - 300K free DNS queries per month, then reverts to no filtering
 - CA\$27.90/year unlimited queries & devices
- AdGuard DNS (<https://adguard-dns.io/en/welcome.html>)
 - 300K free DNS queries per month, then reverts to no filtering
 - US\$19.99/year, 10M queries, 20 devices
- LibreDNS (<https://libredns.gr/>)
 - crowd-sourced list of known advertising & tracking domains
 - completely free
- Control D (<https://controld.com/>)
 - US\$12/year per endpoint
- DeCloudUs (<https://decloudus.com/index.html>)
 - free – “**prone to downtime**”, throttled, one server in Germany
 - US\$5.88/year, not throttled, servers around world
- BlahDNS (<https://blahdns.com/>)
 - free (donationware), servers in Singapore & Germany
- AhaDNS Blitz (<https://ahadns.com/>)
 - free (donationware), servers in “most major cities of the world”

- Aim is to be able to match expertise to requests for assistance

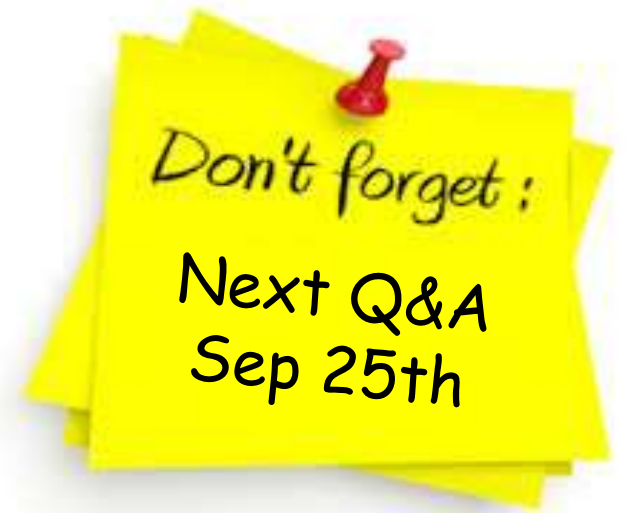
